Earlier this year, a bit of uncertainty was caused when the Bread Buddies initiative suddenly

came to a halt. As Westerfordians, we are well aware of the difficult circumstances faced by the majority of schools in our province, and particularly the lack of food that children at these schools receive.



Bringing an extra sandwich every Tuesday seemed to be both an important responsibility as well as a contribution towards dealing with these circumstances.



Thankfully, through Interact, a suitable school was soon found which is most appreciative of the

sandwiches on a weekly basis. A system of collection and distribution between Westerford and Ummangaliso Primary in Khayelitsha was set up, and Bread Buddies was re-launched shortly thereafter.

Over time, the Interact committee began to realise that although the sandwiches are a worthwhile means of supporting Ummangaliso, the children tend to lack basic stationery such as books and pens. When thinking of any lesson during the Westerford school day, each begins with the instruction to "Take out your book and pen". It's impossible to imagine teaching hundreds of children effectively without these necessities.



Interact and Equal Education have decided to hold a week-long Stationery Drive in order to help Ummangaliso acquire basic stationery for their pupils. Items such as pens, pencils, exam pads or lined books will be greatly appreciated, and are to be placed in the box in the Front Office.

The drive will be running between Monday 19 and Friday 23 August, and is a simple and easy way to help improve significantly the daily school lives of many.
